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0:00 Well, MK Ultra may sound like a conspiracy theory, something out of Jason Bourne movies where the CIA

0:07 performs mind control on unwitting CIA agents. But it's much bigger than that.

0:12 And it's not a conspiracy theory at all. In fact, it's very real and it's very alive and well today by the deep state,

0:19 by the CIA, by the shadow government that is running things. How do we know that? Because our next guest was the

0:26 victim of that. His entire family was the victim of an MK Ultra, some sort of directed energy weapon attack against

0:33 his family. And that person happened to work for the CIA, 17 years as a CIA

0:38 veteran. He's written multiple books on the subject. And his most recent book is Twilight of the Shadow Government and

0:44 how this deep state is this deep state rot needs to be eliminated from America.

0:50 Kevin Ship is his name and he joins us now. Kevin, thank you for being here. Welcome back to the show. Uh, thank you,

0:56 Clayton. Good to be back with you. So, you and I have talked a number of times here on the show, but today I

1:01 really wanted to zero in and focus on MK Ultra and mind control and these

1:08 nefarious weapons that the agency has at their disposal. Um, the deep state has

1:14 at its disposal. Maybe you can just take us to a 30,000 foot level. Um, when someone say this is conspiracy theories,

1:20 these are propaganda. They don't have this stuff. What do you say to somebody like that? Well, that's what I used to think. Uh,

1:27 you know, when I was a good uh CI officer, um, I didn't think those things

1:33 existed. This stuff is compartmented at the high level, probably top secret SCI. Uh, I didn't I didn't know they were

1:39 there until they were used on me. uh which was a a great eye opener and

1:44 I had uh done an international investigation and uncovered a serious vulnerability in US embassies where any

1:50 foreign national in the visa section could go through the unclassified computer hack in and identify the names

1:57 and the addresses of our case officers and chief of stations and by extension their assets in that country. So I put

2:03 together a extensive report sent it to CIA management. I got a phone call from the division involved. Ominous call from the division chief telling me to drop drop it. Uh do not investigate it

2:09 further. It would be my career. Then he hung up. Uh then then my report was deleted from the CI headquarters server. Uh I sent it four times to the division involved. Each time they they claimed

2:27 that they'd lost it or they never got it. Well, my report leaked out to the Department of State I senior IG and I

2:34 got a call one day. Listen, Kevin, uh, we think you may be on to something here. Do not tell the CIA that you're

2:40 involved in this or we're doing this. We're going to go worldwide and do an investigation in embassies and see if what you may have uncovered is true.

2:48 Keep your head low and you'll hear hear from us in about 3 months. Sure enough, 3 months later, the secure phone rings.

2:53 I pick it up and I'll call him Jim. He says, "Kev, you need to get over Main State immediately. Can you do that?"

2:59 Yes, sir. So, I went over there and uh they buzzed me into the the big conference room with a long walnut table

3:05 and and they said, "Kev, uh it's not as just as bad as you thought. It is worse." We were able to go to every

3:12 single embassy, go into the visa section with all the foreign nationals and hack right in and identify CIA cover officers

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3:18 in those embassies. Uh and he he said, "Now, just hold on. We got another visitor coming. I had no idea this was

3:25 going to happen. We have another visitor coming. Uh wait about 10 minutes. the door buzzes. They escort him in and in

3:31 walks the GS-15 CIA uh manager that was in charge of of

3:36 that program and had destroyed my documents and had threatened me. And they said, "Sir, sir, have a seat at the

3:43 end of the table." And state IG stood up and said, "Consider this an official rebuke by Department of State IG to you,

3:50 the CIA, for putting the lives of your agents at risk for over 10 years and then covering it up." And and he froze

3:57 in shock. And I sat there and watched my career dissolve. Uh, and then they said, "You can go now." Oh, and they said,

4:03 "One last thing. This report is going to be published to the entire intelligence community so they see what the CIA has

4:09 done." Well, he walked out kind of in shock. I remember they thanked me and I

4:14 I I thanked them for all the work they did. And I went back to headquarters and was just kind of left on my own. Um, and

4:21 uh, it was like I had a laser dot, figuratively speaking, on my back. I knew they were coming for me eventually.

4:27 So anyway, uh they assigned me subsequent to that to a secret base inside the United States um and

4:35 uh commanded that I and my family move on to this base and they moved us into a house that the CI knew was contaminated.

4:42 The previous residents had been evacuated because they were very ill. So they moved us in into that house

4:48 intentionally on orders of the the chief of the base and uh within golly three

4:54 months uh everybody started getting desperately ill. Um my kids throats were

5:00 swelling up. Um I had to take them to emergency room a couple times. Uh we were having severe headaches. Uh my wife

5:07 uh uh was was basically bedridden with dementia. Um so um there was something

5:13 very we knew there was a poison in that house. It wound up being, excuse me, the house was riddled through the walls with

5:19 black mold. It was also leaking what's a micotoxin, which which is a chemical weapon that Saddam Hussein used in Iraq.

5:26 It was a yellow rain. Uh, I found that leaking in the ceiling. And the only way you can find it that the CI didn't count

5:32 on was I I I researched and found a black light will cause these micotoxins to grow iridescent green. So, I hit the

5:40 ceiling with the black light and sure enough, there were micotoxins leaking in which is which is a neurotoxin leaking

5:46 in through the ceiling. Um, took my attorney back. Uh, we we left the house,

5:52 someone broke in, we came back and make a long story short, took my attorney back, we hit the ceiling in with a black

5:57 light and someone had broken in and painted some chemical over the micotoxin and they didn't realize I was using a

6:02 black light. So, we caught him breaking in and trying to cover that up. And I remember Clint Hero, my attorney, looked

6:09 at me. He goes, "Man, this is like three days of the condor." I'm like, "Goodness gracious." And then it got worse from there. So, I contacted the CIA and told

6:16 them, and we did. We filed suit against the rental company. We we had a rental property on this residence. And uh we

6:24 filed a complaint for the the black mold. And I used that as uh the reason I

6:29 had the authority to do this. I requested that the CIA give my attorney Clinch B CI clearance. Now, the CIA

6:36 always refuses you having your own attorney, if you may know this, but you

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6:41 have to use a CIA attorney. They have to have control of all of your documents, all
of your evidence in CI headquarters,
6:48 and then they classify it. Well, I knew that, so I got my attorney cleared with a
secret clearance uh telling the CI
6:55 that it was for the rental uh claim that we had. So, they granted him a clearance.
We turned around and we sued them for a personal injury complaint
7:02 because of my family was desperately ill. My son Joyy's immune system was so
7:07 bad uh they said it looked like he had AIDS. We tested him twice, he didn't.
Another immunologist said it looked like
7:13 he'd been exposed to a burst of radiation. So after after that the poisoning uh and
everybody got really
7:20 sick, I filed suit and that's when the fun began. We were bugged. We were
followed. Uh, and then this weird
7:27 neurological uh, stuff started happening. Uh, my wife started getting severe
headaches so bad the doctor put
7:34 her on morphine and he couldn't tell what was causing it. It put he put her on
morphine then she got dementia and
7:40 and was bedridden. Uh, my oldest son uh, was having severe headaches. Uh, he
got
7:45 the symptoms of PTSD, serious anxiety attacks. uh my two
7:50 little kids who who eventually started losing their sight from some neurological
issue. Uh and of course uh
7:58 they went after all of us with whatever this thing was. My son got the worst of it and
because I had signed a secrecy
8:05 agreement and they thought they could use that to shut me up. Well, I think
everybody knows now that that didn't work, but uh Joey didn't. And so he knew
8:12 some of the things on that base that they didn't want the public to know about. So,
I think they went after him with a vengeance and uh really damaged
8:20 his him neurological. He was diagnosed and I have the doctor's diagnosis that I
sent you. Uh he was diagnosed with
8:26 severe PTSD. Uh he couldn't work. Uh couldn't provide for his family. He sank
8:32 sank down into a deep depression and and now we don't know where he is. He's
living somewhere in Florida. We're
8:37 trying to find him. Uh and uh ever since then to this day, he's been been very
8:43 very sick. uh my now former wife because this basically ended our marriage. She
8:49 has PTSD and is too terrified of the CIA to even speak about it. Um so uh we were

8:55 hit with something that permanently damaged every single one of us neurological
uh neur neurologically
9:02 rather. And it wasn't until uh I put all the pieces together because I try to
9:07 stay, you know, with the facts and the evidence that I have and the doctor's
diagnosis and all of that because that's important, right, for credibility sake.
9:15 And after I put it all together, it became pretty clear to me that we had been hit with
some sort of uh electric
9:20 weapon that would that had damaged every single one of us neurologically. Now,
an IG officer, senior IG officer came out

now obviously that they were
11:20 hitting with our family with some neurological weapon and my kids were just
collateral damage because they were after me. When you look at the
11:27 documents, so I just want to put up some of these documents here on the screen,
Kevin, that you've sent to you've sent
11:33 to us from the doctors and uh, and these reports. Can you tell us what we're
seeing here? And you can maybe just give us an overview of these documents.

23:18 demonic or was it some CI scout trying to scare everybody? Which wouldn't surprise me knowing them on the base

23:25 just, you know, just as a as a form of manipulation. Let's talk about this MK Ultra program.

23:30 So, if people hear this, what do most people think it is and what what is the truth behind what the MK Ultra program

23:37 is? I mean, maybe separate from your story or maybe tied directly to what happened to you with this neurological

23:43 electronic attack. Yeah, MK Ultra was a a horrific CI

23:49 operation where they were using drugs, different drugs, LSD, uh, measculine and

23:55 other things without the knowledge of the participants to monitor their brain activity. The goal was to to create a

24:02 born-like super soldier who they could program to go into war willing to die

24:08 and and and just be kind of uh controlled mentally or be a data mule

24:14 where they would program an agent would go and deliver the information to another agent overseas and then he'd

24:19 completely forget the information he was just given based based on his programming. So he was a data mule and

24:25 if they caught him and interrogated him they wouldn't find anything. Uh uh so so they were uh they were engaging in

24:32 sexual abuse with with these people. Um sleep deprivation uh um beatings. Uh

24:40 even Ted Kazinski went through MK Ultra and he was I think he went through 200 hours of torture in MK MK Ultra. Um

24:47 hypnosis, verbal assault, just just basically mental torture to see if they could break the mind down and then

24:54 reprogram it. Uh and that is basically what the CIA is is is doing those sorts

25:01 of things and they do it in the cover of darkness. Uh and they use various forms of torture too. So uh and then the the

25:07 question is did it go away? Uh when the church committee happened and Frank Church brought it out that MK Ultra

25:14 existed, well the the stuff hit the fan and everybody started screaming, "We

25:20 need more of this." Well, Richard Helms, the director of the CIA, immediately destroyed 10,000 MK Ultra documents so

25:27 that Congress couldn't see them and then threatened the CI officers who were who were due to testify with prison if they

25:33 violated their secrecy agreement. They tried that with me. Uh, so that's one of the means of control. So MK Ultra, they

25:39 said after the church committee, uh, well, we don't do that anymore. It's been done away with. Well, Victor Marcetti, who wrote CI and cult of

25:46 Intelligence, I don't know if you aware of that book, he was the first real CI whistleblower. He said uh they claimed

25:52 MK Ultra stopped in 1973 but he said that's just a cover story. It continued after that and Victor Marcetti Marcetti

25:59 was a very well-known CI whistleblower who wrote a the first real book on the CI called CI and cult of intelligence. Uh there's an author Elizabeth Nicholson

26:04 who's done studies. She she is convinced

26:12 MK Ultra still exists. And one of the classic examples is Sirhan Sirhan who uh

26:18 was one of the shooters that killed um Robert Kennedy senior. Siran Sirhan um

26:25 claimed he didn't remember anything about the event at all afterwards. And they went in there and they tested him psychologically and he was so

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26:32 programmable they had him climbing his cell like a monkey. And Bobby Kennedy Jr. and I have become friends because of

26:38 our both of our kind of disenchantment to say that with the CIA and Bobby met

26:44 with Siran Sirhan and he said he did he had no idea of what what he'd done uh at

26:49 all no memory of it at all and the psych psychiatrists were easy were so easy it was so easy rather to program him that

26:55 that they had him climbing the hill like I said like a monkey he was I'm convinced an MK ultra subject I'm

27:01 absolutely convinced of this I don't want to speak for Bobby Kennedy Jr. We've become friends since, but I think

27:06 you would probably agree with that as a classic case of it still existing. I did

27:11 a program and interviewed a lady named Carol Warner. And Carol Warner is the

27:16 daughter of John Warner, who is the chief counsel for the director of the CI, Richard Helms. And Carol Warner said

27:24 her dad uh couldn't take it anymore. MK Ultra was going on. Her dad uh Helm's

27:30 attorney quit because of the evil things he was saying. told her that that Richard Helms was the most evil man he'd

27:36 ever seen and he just couldn't participate in things like MK Ultra. I interviewed her and she has since become

27:41 a psychotherapist and has several cases of patients that have been subjects of

27:46 MK Ultra and display all the symptoms. Uh she's out there, right? I think it's carolner.com I think is her website. Uh

27:54 and she's still interviewing people uh in their adult years that underwent this kind of psychological torture. So they

28:01 they tell us that it went away in 1973. And just to get some timelines out here,

28:06 of course, the RFK assassination was 1968, so carried on well past that. We've heard

28:13 from other MK Ultra whistleblowers who've come forward and talked about it in the years since. And why would they give up such a powerful weapon? You can

28:20 mind control individuals who can carry out assassinations or pretend to be an assassin as a pathy and be caught while

28:28 actual CIA agents are actually shooting and killing JFK or shooting and killing RFK in a kitchen um in Los Angeles.

28:35 So, it's a very convenient and then we can see of course what's been unfolding over the past couple of months and you

28:41 know assassination of Charlie Kirk and and all of these things. So, it seems like it's still very prevalent. But

28:47 maybe you can talk about Venezuela because we we reported here a few weeks ago on Redacted that they used a

28:54 directed energy weapon um and covering of course what Venezuelan soldiers were saying they were seeing as these

29:00 operations were these special forces were coming into into Venezuela and they'd never seen anything like it.

29:06 their men, their soldiers just sort of collapsed on the floor, felt like their heads were exploding. And then we heard

29:11 from President Trump who then confirmed it. Well, first from Carolyn Levit, the secret, the press secretary, and then

29:17 from President Trump himself confirming it. So this whole like idea of a conspiracy theory. Now, I've talked to

29:23 separate sources who tell me that the technology they used in Venezuela is well over 20 years old.

29:29 That's correct. And and and as you pointed out very often when we learn about this technology, you said it about

29:35 20 minutes ago, it's been around then for like 20 years. By the time we actually start to hear about it, it's

29:40 already been around for 20 years. So this technology goes back about 20 years. According to my sources, Russia

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29:46 has it and has used it in Ukraine. China has it has access to the same almost the
exact same type of technology. So do you
29:54 see similarities with MK Ultra and what we saw in Venezuela? Sorry, it's a long
question, but yeah. No, no, no worries. Uh oh yeah.
30:01 Yeah, they did use that weapon there without question. There witnesses that
witnessed them using it. Uh no doubt
30:06 about it. And and uh that's part of the reason they were able to go in so quickly
and so successfully is they just
30:12 mentally put down the adversary with that weapon. That's I think that's pretty much
an established fact that
30:18 they used it there. And uh knowing what the CIA does to destroy whistleblowers,
30:25 I Gary Webb is a prime example. They drove him to well, they wound up in a hotel
room with two bullets in his head.
30:31 They claimed it was a suicide, but they literally drove him into a deep depression
by destroying every part of
30:36 his life. And they have a whole program to do that. They tried it on me to ruin you
mentally, financially, take away
30:43 your health insurance, your your retirement, threaten you with prison, if you violate
the state secret privilege,
30:48 and just destroy you mentally and physically to shut you up. know I I I humbly am a
person of faith. So I kind
30:55 of answered to a higher authority and and I was not afraid of them. Plus I was
them. I was a high ranking officer. So I
31:02 knew what they were going to do and was two steps ahead of them every time like
getting my attorney clear which they
31:07 didn't they didn't bank on me being prepared like that. They they're doing these
evil things and they're doing it
31:13 to people's minds especially whistleblowers or or anybody in the case of Gary
Webb a journalist who digs too
31:19 deep. That's why journalists don't do it. They're afraid of CIA retribution. And we
we're not seeing any journalistic
31:25 investigations of the CIA anymore because they're terrified of them because they
want them to be afraid of
31:31 that. When you look back at the weapon that was used on you and this
neurological attack, have you been able to dig more
31:38 deeply into it? You have the documentation from the doctors on this and what was
happening to your
31:43 children's sight, um, PTSD, dementia in your wife, what was happening to you.
31:49 Have you been able to identify maybe specifically from your research what this
weapon is?
31:56 No, not specifically. And that's that's one of the problems with the abuse of
secrecy. You know, they're concealing
32:03 this. So, we we can't find out exactly how these things work except for the
32:08 overt use of them like in in Venezuela and other places. No, I know that that
32:14 weapons in science out there exist to alter the human mind like that and and
damage the human mind in some university
32:21 studies. Now, would the CIA use those studies? You're darn too they will. Uh
32:26 the CIA is all about control. And it it's helpful to remember, I think most
32:32 people do, that the CIA has no morals whatsoever. It's a dark at the upper
32:37 levels at 20% upper levels. It is a dark demonic agency that will do anything to
32:43 accomplish its mission in its own eyes. Its version of national security which is the
preservation of the CIA. They
32:49 will do anything. Would they do this? Absolutely. If there are university studies on
on neurological
32:56 attacks, uh would they use that and and in the science department expand on
that? You bet they would. Have I seen

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33:02 that weapon uh personally? No, I have not. And so that's the that's the dilemma
because this stuff is so highly
33:08 classified and they're holding it. Uh so not even Congress can see what they're
doing like the Church Committee. Uh they
33:15 destroyed Frank Church's uh career. If you remember, they threatened Frank
Church, the CIA did and said, "If you
33:20 take this any further, we're going to ruin your career." Well, he did because he was
a good man. And sure enough, they
33:25 ruined his career. Both he and Otis Pike lost their elections the next time around.
Congress today is afraid of
33:30 that. That's why they're manipulated by the CIA also. Which brings me to another
important point if I may. There's mass
33:38 mind control by the CIA in that they've got Congress and the Senate terrified of
them. If they dig too deep. Uh this
33:46 remember the famous quote by Chuck Schumer. If you cross the intelligence
community, they have six ways from
33:51 Sunday getting back at you. And he was serious. Well, they do. I know. I've
33:56 been there. So the congressman and senators even on the oversight committees
know if they dig too deep in the CIA it's the end of their career

similarities or maybe this is
34:09 the same type of weapon from what we've seen with Havana syndrome reports?
34:16 I do I think it's the same type of weapon and I think it's even more sophisticated
than that. Uh, I think they've got the frequencies down more
34:23 sophisticated than that. And I think Avanis syndrome, I think that's old technology
personally and I think
34:28 they've advanced on that. I'm convinced of that. I'm trying to understand some of
the
34:34 mechanics here. Maybe you can paint a picture without telling us this base
specifically, but you're at this secret
34:40 CIA base that's, as you mentioned, it's been now revealed in the New York Times
and the Washington Post, and I
34:46 understand you can't say where it is, but maybe you could just describe the house
that you were in and what was
34:52 around you and did you see anything that led you to believe that this weapon was
34:58 being used in a truck or from a mile away, two miles away? Have you thought
35:03 about that or researched that? Well, we had trucks parked um two streets down
from our house all the time
35:10 and we also knew that that there was a the actually chief of the base was in the
woods doing something when when I
35:18 first filed our suit. And then when we moved to Jacksonville, Florida, my my now
current wife uh there were vehicles
35:25 parked right outside our house uh with a man and a woman just sitting in them.
35:31 And I went out in one case and confronted them and they just drove off looking
straight ahead. But uh during
35:36 that time, my current wife, both of us got hit with this severe depression at the
same time that lasted about two days
35:43 out of nowhere. Uh uh she herself would testify some something's going on. We
35:49 were hit with something. Uh, so they're doing it, but they're doing it under the
35:54 cloak of secrecy, which as you know, my mission is to come out and expose the
CIA's grotesque abuse of secrecy to
36:00 cover up its criminal activity. This is one example. Some of the UAVs that we're
seeing, uh, that's another example of
36:07 programs that that are highly classified. In some cases, as Mike Pompeo and
James Woolseie, former
36:14 directors of the CIA said, the CIA is engaging in operations that not even the
director of the CIA knows about. these

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36:20 the upper level parts of the agency. It's dark. It's immoral. Doesn't believe in the constitution and that's what we
36:26 have to address and do something about. How widespread do you think this program
36:31 is MK Ultra today? Do you think it's I mean now it's probably buried deep deep
36:38 down and at the highest levels classified but h you know if you were to say there's a hundred people working on
36:44 this program 50 people working on this program they've got agents around the world who are fully aware of it there's
36:51 sleeper agents like Jason Bourne style agents who have been manipulated in this way how big do you think it is at this
36:57 stage in 2026 this kind of program they would have at least a branch level staff, probably
37:04 division level staff that would would be running this thing. And I've spoken all over the country and and uh u on this
37:12 issue. And I've had multiple people come up to me that were targeted individuals
37:17 that were being one day they're normal and the next day they're they're being hit with symptoms of of schizophrenia or
37:24 symptoms of severe anxiety and they've actually come up and pleaded with me to for help. Uh there's a lot of people out
37:31 there that this is happening to. Carol Warner uh the lady I talked about who's who's treating some of these people has
37:38 multiple patients coming in that have been subjects of MK Ultra and she's ab as a therapist she's absolutely
37:44 convinced. So there's a lot of people out there that are suffering from this and uh some of them have gotten together
37:50 with targeted individual groups and and and and it's tough because I've met some of them. I'm convinced that they are
37:56 being hit with these weapons. a former NASA scientist and his wife came up to me and I was absolutely they were being
38:03 hit. And then other people you don't know if well you know is this a chemical imbalance or well if they didn't have
38:09 the chemical imbalance one day and the next morning they do okay something's going on there. So with with secret
38:15 programs it's like reaching out in the dark trying to find the cause which is
38:20 why the system is so diabolical. Um so I'm convinced that that these exist. I I
38:27 know there CIA whistleblowers out there that will never have a star on the wall that were destroyed. We'll never have a
38:33 star on the wall, will never be heard from, and their lives. I know of at least one person, their lives were completely ruined. Uh and it was
38:39 mentally. So, I'm convinced it exists and uh someone's got to investigate it
38:45 somehow. I wish we'd see another church committee. I don't think Congress has the guts to do it, to take that risk.
38:51 So, as I always say, it's up to we the people to start demanding that Congress take an action and reform the CIA. And
38:58 something that Bobby Kennedy Jr. especially and I are passionate about, taking the CIA apart and taking its
39:03 gross abuse of secrecy and clandestine operation away from it and and put it in a new agency or some other agency that's
39:11 accountable to Congress. Wouldn't that be great? I mean, we, you know, we see like the USAD program,
39:16 right? It was all a big uproar. We're dismantling this, you know, this Democrat machine that's uh funneling
39:24 money to different countries. It's a big money laundering operation. It's doing all sorts of horrible illegal things,
39:30 including child trafficking. So, yeah, we can all get behind removing USA ID.

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39:35 And then what happens is it gets reformulated and and funneled underneath
Marco Rubio's State

39:47 it's maybe as nefar maybe now more nefarious because it was out in the open,

39:53 worry about that. Like that's what I worry about if we dismantle the CIA. You know,
you've got you've got the
39:59 space force has its own intelligence program now. What are there 18 of these
intelligence agencies?
40:05 17 total agencies involved in secret intelligence work. and Clayton in terms of mind
control what that means is with
40:12 for example all the CIA contractors like Loheed Martin SEIC Booz and Hamilton all
of those they have tens of thousands I
40:20 think it's over over a million at least employees that have a CIA clearance have
signed a CIA secrecy agreement as part
40:26 of that contract and are now absolutely controlled by the CIA will never speak out
because it means the end of their
40:32 career provision for their family their health insurance and their retirement so there
are tens of thousands of Americans
40:37 out there bound by this system which is another form of mass mind control in my
opinion that they're frozen and they
40:43 can't see even even if they see something illegal or unconstitutional which some
do they they're terrified to
40:49 say anything about it because the CIA will hit them with violating their secrecy
agreement which they tried to do to me and threaten them with prison and
40:55 that's how they do it. Yeah. I one night not too long ago I was
41:01 I wasn't drinking uh but this individual uh who worked for Northrup Grumman was
41:07 drinking and uh revealed that he was working for Northrup Grumman and that he
41:13 signed you know he has secret clearance and he can't talk about things but I said
it's pretty dark stuff as you know
41:19 and he he fully admitted that's it would shock the American people if they knew
what dark things that they were working
41:25 on but he's like sworn to secrecy. Yeah, exactly. Loheed Martin is the
41:30 domestic surveillance spying arm of the CIA. And a lot of people don't know this.
Loheed Martin has
41:37 he worked he worked for Loheed, not North. That's a bad one. Yeah, that's a bad
one. Lheed Martin has a
41:44 contract, intelligence contract where they scan every piece of mail that comes
through the US post office. And most
41:49 people don't know that. And I've gotten several letters that were pre-opened. I
mean, I joke and say, "Yeah, there are
41:54 some perks being a CI whistleblower." my mail is open before I get it. Well, sadly
that's true. Uh when the first
42:01 batch of uh Twilight of the Shadow government came, I have a picture out on
Twitter. Uh when when the my box of
42:07 Twilight of the Shadow government, which CI tried to stop came, it it had been
sliced open and someone had been in
42:12 there. So, Lockheed monitors the US mail and they monitor our mail that goes
through the the the US post office.
42:19 They're a massive CIA contractor. Do would you say every piece of mail is
monitored by Loheed Martin? That's what
42:25 I understand. Every piece of mail or suspic mail that they they want to target like
me for
42:32 example, I don't know. Uh uh but they have a program where they have the
authority to monitor every single piece

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42:38 of mail that comes to the US post office. Whether they look at them all or just specific targeted ones, I would

42:44 think they do specific targeted ones just by the sheer volume, but they're doing it. Wow. Wow. And that could explain why if

42:52 you're expecting something important, it seems to take longer, you know, espe if you've got a target on your back. Well,

42:57 it was supposed to be here two days. Well, it's it's taken a week and a half. That's odd. That's really it never arrives.

43:09 I'm just curious about this weapon. I just I I keep coming back to it because Sure.

43:14 I'm sure you're connecting the dots for a lot of Americans, a lot of people who've maybe been subject to these type

43:20 of weapons by the CIA. I've spoken to whistleblowers in the MK Ultra program who've told me absolutely horrible

43:26 things where they've been programmed, they've been programmed to watch members of the US military fight to the death.

43:46 programming. Um where they have to like then compartmentalize it and not remember it and they're only able to like recall it

43:52 once they get out and then they're targeted permanently. I'm talking programs where they won't even drive

43:57 cars anymore. They have electronics in the cars because they've been run off the road. So they just drive bikes. They

44:03 ride bikes now. Um because my son that exact same thing happened to my son. Yeah. Yep. They're doing it. Yeah.

44:10 He was run off the road. He was run off the road. He was followed, tailed, and then they they came up and slammed his

44:15 car, ran him off the road, and a couple that was on the scene called me to say this. No, it's true that we saw it

44:22 happen. And then they took off and Joey said, "Look, Dad, this happened." And here's to And sure enough, that's what happened. They did they did several

44:29 things to him because I think they they consider him a threat because he never signed a secrecy agreement and he knows

44:34 a lot of what is on that base. And uh uh his mail was routinely open. Uh so and

44:42 what what does a 17-year-old kid do when the most powerful dark organization in the world is targeting you? Uh every day

44:50 and and they they are they were um imagine what that does to a young young

44:55 kid's mind that's only 17 years old, you know. Can't imagine. Awful. Awful. So just as

45:00 I wrap things up here, I just want to talk a little bit more about this weapon and how you felt the effects of this.

45:06 Um, were you just sitting there reading a book, reading a newspaper, watching

45:12 the news, and suddenly you just felt felt odd or was it a slow a slow burn?

45:17 No, it was immediate. In the case of my wife and I, we're sitting there in the living room and all of a sudden, oh, and

45:24 and we just go into this deep depression, both of us, at the same time. And it stayed for two days. We

45:31 we're like, I I knew what it was. was I told her I said, "Honey, we're being hit." That she's absolutely convinced.

45:37 Two days it was gone. It was just removed. Uh that's what it's like. And on the base with uh the headaches and

45:43 the bloody noses and things, boom, it just hit virtually overnight. Uh so yeah, you start you start feeling this

45:51 horrible anxiety in your head just hits you like this. And I mean, it's awful. You try to sleep at night and and there

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45:57 it is, you know, just just kind of vibrating. uh uh you start slipping into this deep uh depression, you start

46:04 having nightmares and then boom, it's gone. So uh that's what it's like. At least that's my experience what it's

46:11 been like. And from your experience, you see these cars parked near your house. Would you think it's something local like it's a

46:16 local sort of microwave focused attack or is it something that's done remotely from like a thousand miles away?

46:24 They I think in some cases they have these things mobile in vehicles. other cases they they can go I understand a

46:31 distance of up to a mile to target somebody specifically and think about the technology they can read our faces

46:38 from via satellite in space they can identify facial recognition from a

46:44 satellite so that that's the kind of technology they have with these weapons uh the the cars parked outside our house

46:51 were routinely a man and a woman in a sedan just sitting there looking straight ahead motionless just sitting

46:57 there until I started going out and confronting him with a flashlight and then they just looking straight ahead would just drive away. It happened

47:03 routinely and we were followed of course my current wife and I. So, um, that's

47:08 why my mission is to is to reveal to the American people what the CIA is and

47:15 especially in this case because I'm convinced they've tormented and are tormenting a lot of people that they

47:21 consider aren't marching to the orders uh coming down from the national

47:27 security state. uh and based on Palunteeer and other things now and predictive programming, if if you're

47:33 against the National Security State, that automatically makes you a target on their list. Uh uh and in the war on

47:39 terror, which got rid of the Constitution and the Patriot Act, they can do these things to you if they consider you a threat to national

47:46 security. Well, look at James Fishbach, right? He's running for governor of Florida. He just announced yesterday that he will

47:52 make palunteeer illegal in the state of Florida. And I thought, "Oh boy, awesome. Good luck with Good luck with

47:58 trying that. I hope he's successful. But I hope he's successful, too. But I thought, man, who just put a who just

48:04 put a huge target on his back, right? Um Yeah. Yeah. by these demonic forces.

48:09 Uh unbelievable, Kevin. I mean, what you've told us today. And um I encourage,

48:15 you know, our audience, please go read Twilight of the Shadow Government. It's an incredible book. We'll have it linked up in the description below. But just

48:21 above and beyond that, thank you for trying to shine a light on MK Ultra, these nefarious weapons that they have

48:27 access to and what they're doing to American patriots who are trying to get our country back to the Constitution, to

48:35 our founding principles in this nation. And it's just it's so heartbreaking. So,

48:40 thank you for sharing your story. Thank you for your bravery, Kevin. And Clay, I want to mention, too, uh uh

48:46 I I came on your show. I've been watching you guys for about a year and

48:51 uh you're one of the shows I trust uh both you and Natalie and and that's why I've come on your show to talk about

48:57 these things because I I really admire you guys and your program and your

49:02 objective journalism. So, thank you too. Thank you. I appreciate that. I that means a lot. Thank you, Kevin. Thank you

49:09 for your bravery and uh we'll talk soon. Thank you so much. Sounds good. Thank you, Clayton. Thank

49:14 you.
